Streetscape/Safety Committee Description

Purpose:

The Purpose of the Streetscape/Safety Committee is to enhance and improve the aesthetic appeal and walkability of Robinson Street by implementing projects and programs with community input and support that accomplish this objective.

Responsibilities:

1. Work with RSA members and other stakeholders to evaluate and prioritize the streetscape and safety needs of Robinson Street.
2. Develop and implement projects and programs to address these needs, including greening with hanging baskets and parklets, adding pedestrian lighting, improving sidewalks, alley issues, adding bike racks, improving crosswalks, working with GRTC on routes, working with the police on safety issues, and improving parking.
3. Be liaison between the RSA and the City as it relates to streetscape and safety projects and programs.
4. Apply for funds needed to implement projects and programs.
5. Research and evaluate proposals that come from members related to streetscape and safety issues.
6. Evaluate special use permit or zoning change requests impacting Robinson Street and make recommendations to the Board on same.
7. Report to the Board of Directors at each Board meeting on progress towards objectives.
8. Obtain approval from the Board of Directors on any new projects or programs.
9. Obtain approval from the Board of Directors for any expenditures not included in the annual budget.

Time Commitment:

One hour meetings will be held monthly or as frequently as needed to accomplish objectives. Committee members will be asked to undertake tasks in addition to attending the Committee meetings. Members must agree to serve for at least one year.
